## Who We Serve

Chileda serves children and young adults, ages 6-21, from across the United States. Youth who enter our program typically have identified cognitive challenges and interfering behaviors.

Professionals may struggle with definitive diagnoses for the students we serve, however autism spectrum disorder, attachment disorder, traumatic brain injury, intermittent explosive disorder, attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, and oppositional defiant disorder are common diagnoses for children who attend Chileda.

Chileda's campus includes four duplexes along with an administrative center containing our school and indoor recreational areas.

Community parks, stores, movie theaters, and restaurants are conveniently located within minutes of our campus, providing opportunities for students to practice and refine social, leisure, and academic skills in a variety of settings.
